1. Point of Care Clarity

- _____ Do visit notes consistently meet your agency's documentation standards?
- _____ Would someone unfamiliar with the patient understand the clinical situation from the documentation alone?

2. QA and Coding Stability

- _____ Does QA primarily confirm documentation rather than rewrite or clarify it?
- _____ Do coding teams rarely need to call clinicians to resolve documentation ambiguity?
- _____ Are inconsistencies between OASIS responses and visit documentation uncommon?

3. Revenue and Audit Exposure

- _____ Are denial trends reviewed for documentation-related root causes?
- _____ Can leadership confidently say documentation would stand up to an external audit?
- _____ Is documentation consistent enough to support predictable reimbursement?

Scoring Guidance:

If you answered:

- 8-9 Yes: Documentation integrity is structurally reinforced.
- 5-7 Yes: Some interpretation likely occurs.
- 4 or fewer Yes: Documentation gaps may be creating operational and financial risk.
